How do I reach Zans by public transport?

Zans is easily and comfortably accessible by public transport.

The Dolomiti Card and Mobilcards are valid - single tickets can be purchased directly on board. [Click here](#) for the bus connections!

Can I travel to Zans free of charge with the Dolomiti Card?

Yes, the Dolomiti Card is available exclusively for all guests of the member establishments of Villnöss Tourism Cooperation. With this guest card all South Tyrolean public transport can be used free of charge and without restrictions.

Are there any refreshment stops on site or in the surrounding area?

There are two mountain huts in the immediate vicinity at the Zans car park. Other huts can be reached by hiking. [Here](#) you can find all the restaurants and mountain huts in the area!

Can I reach Zans also in winter?

The starting point Zans is accessible all year round and can be reached by public transport, on foot or by private car. Also in winter, numerous winter hiking trails and toboggan runs start from there. Please note that winter tyres and/or chains are compulsory for your car on snow-covered roads or when there is ice on the roadway.

Where is parking available?

Paid parking is available in Zans and St. Magdalena/Ranui. Attention: The parking spaces are limited.





Could coaches reach the starting point Zans?

Yes, coaches can reach Zans. However, care must be taken not to cross the bus of the public line in the Ranui - Zans section, as the road is narrower on that route. Therefore, it is necessary to study the public bus timetables in advance. There is also only limited parking for coaches.

Could campers reach the starting point Zans?

Yes, campers are also allowed to reach the parking area at Zans. A different fee applies for campers. The camper can also stay parked overnight. Camping, however, is prohibited.

Are there public toilets?

The toilets are located in the rear area of the hut Treffpunkt Zans.
